Que: Your performance in this module will be assessed through two main components, with specific weightings for each:

1. Presentation of Doctoral Thesis Proposal (80%) The majority of your grade (80%) will come from the presentation of your doctoral thesis proposal. During this stage, you will be required to deliver a comprehensive, articulate, and well-structured presentation of your proposal. The goal is to showcase your ability to present your research clearly and to defend the key aspects of your proposed study.

Evaluation criteria for the presentation will include the clarity of your presentation: Can you communicate your research clearly and effectively? The depth of your understanding: Are you demonstrating thorough knowledge of your research topic, its context, and relevant literature? And the coherence and scholarly rigor of the proposed research: Is your methodology sound? Are your research objectives clear and achievable?

2. Interview and Defense of Thesis Proposal with the Doctoral Committee (20%) In addition to the presentation, you will also undergo an interview and defense session with the Doctoral Committee, accounting for 20% of your final grade. This is a crucial element of the assessment, as it provides an opportunity for committee members to engage with you directly on the details of your proposal. During the interview, you will be asked questions, challenged on aspects of your proposal, and expected to respond to critiques. This component assesses your ability to articulate, defend, and justify your research in an intellectual discourse with esteemed academics in your field.

Your proposal should be not exceeding 7,500 words - excluding references in Harvard style, cover page, abstract, table of contents, bibliography, and appendices. Use appropriate referencing and ensure clarity in your argumentation. Assignments must be professionally

presented, proofread, and submitted by the deadline communicated by your e-mentor. The length limitation is in place to ensure that your proposal is focused and succinct, highlighting your ability to convey your ideas clearly while demonstrating scholarly depth and precision. This assignment is an opportunity for you to demonstrate your ability to plan, present, and defend a significant academic project. It is designed to test your capacity to communicate your research ideas effectively and engage in high-level academic discussion. Please remember that both components (the presentation and the interview) are integral to the successful completion of your thesis proposal process.
